

Isles of Scilly Camp, Summer 2012.

After many successful camps on the Scillys, the PPCA (Port of Plymouth Canoeing Association) is organising one for 2012. The camp site at Peliistry on St Mary's is *provisionally* booked for two-weeks. Dates; Friday 27th July to Friday 10th August. If we have enough numbers to run the camp, confirmation will be before the end of December 2011. You can come for any one or both of these weeks. The camp site consists of:- two marquees, ten sleeping tents, wash tents and flushing toilets. There are also showers available at the adjacent farm. All sleeping tents are provided with floorboards and mattresses. One marquee has cooking facilities the other has trestle tables and chairs.

The cost of the campsite will be £108 per person per week for each adult and child over 15 years old. Children over 2 years and under 15 years old will be £54 per person per week.

The cheapest way to travel to the island is by ferry, 2011 prices are Adult £95 return, Child (2-15yrs on date of travel) £47.50, Infant return (under 2yrs) £24. If you book your ferry tickets via me, I should be able to get a group discount.

The following prices are all for 2011. Kayaks and bikes can be transported on the ferry by arrangement. If you let me know as soon as possible, I may be able to arrange a trailer and group rate for transporting these. Individual Kayaks cost £62.00 each. Bikes cost £24.00 each. If enough people travel to the Scilly's by ferry then we should be able to have our own container to carry our gear in and then we share the cost of having the container transported to the field for us. If not, you will need to transport your own things to the site, or Island Carriers can transport it there at a cost of approx. £1 per item.

The PPCA take no responsibility for any activities undertaken during these two weeks. If wanted you will need to take out your own insurance cover for holiday, personal equipment etc. Families of 4 or more will be able to sleep in the tents provided, there is a possibility that smaller groups will have to share with others or bring their own small personal tents to use. (Personal tents are not officially permitted, but we have managed to get around this in the past, but it can't be guaranteed).
